COVID-19 Response / Planning

June 5, 2020 Briefing

The Grant County Health Department has reported **288, confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 23 deaths** in Grant County.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 36,578 total positive cases of COVID-19 and 2,078 deaths and 291,638 tests in the state of Indiana.

Governor Eric J. Holcomb yesterday signed Executive Order 20-30 to extend the public health emergency for an additional 30 days to July 4th.

Grant County remains on track with stage 3 of the Governor's plan for reopening Indiana. The EOC has been assisting the Grant County Health Department as well as many civic organizations and local leaders with event planning and reopening different areas of the county to the public. However there are still many areas and establishments that remain closed and some events have already been canceled for the year.

The next food distribution for Marion Community School s will be Wednesday June 10th at Justice Middle School from 08:30 to 10:30.

Eastbrook Community School Corporation Food distribution will be Monday June 8th from 3:00 to 6:00 at Upland and Van Buren elementary schools.

Second Harvest will be conducting a tailgate on Tuesday June 9th at five Points Mall starting at 10:00 AM
