0900 Daily Briefing;

The Grant County Health Department has reported 54, confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 3 deaths in Grant County.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 10,641 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 554 deaths and 56,873 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

Grant County is currently experiencing a COVID-19 virus outbreak. However most of these new cases are mainly confined to at least one long-term care facility and not at MGH.

IAP – Incident Action Plan;

Our mission remains the same and that is to support the Grant County Health Department, Marion General Hospital and Long-term Care Facilities located in Grant County. The Grant County EOC will continue maintain situational awareness, rebuild Personnel protective equipment inventory for healthcare workers and first responders, and be prepared for the duration of this pandemic.
